Spring Registration Information

ONLINE, MAIL-IN, OR MOORE PARK OFFICE REGISTRATION AVAILABLE

Pre-registration by mail can be done by filling out the enclosed registration form and sending the fee to LYSA, P.O. Box 91205, Lafayette, La., 70509, and postmarked no later than January 21, 2010. Checks should be made payable to LYSA.

Fees for a returning fall 2009 player are \$50.00.

Fees for a player that did not play in the fall are \$80.00 and include a complete uniform (Jersey, shorts, and socks).

Fees for returning fall players that need a new uniform are \$70.00.

If you do not want your child to return to his/her team, **YOU MUST INDICATE THIS WHEN YOU SEND IN YOUR REGISTRATION.**

Registration will be held at Moore Park at the soccer office and Academy Sports on Saturday, January 23, 2010 from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Not Just Soccer will be at Moore Park with available soccer equipment.

All new players must provide proof of age.

TO ENSURE THAT THE SEASON IS STARTED ON TIME, IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT COACHES TAKE AN ACTIVE PART IN PRE-SEASON REGISTRATION. ANYONE INTERESTED IN COACHING A TEAM, REGARDLESS OF EXPERIENCE, SHOULD NOTIFY THE PROPER AGE GROUP COMMISSIONER OF THEIR INTENT AND ENCOURAGE PLAYERS TO REGISTER BY JANUARY 23, 2010. COACHES AND PLAYERS WILL BE ACCEPTED ON A FIRST COME BASIS.

TURF TYKES

SOCCER FOR 3 YEAR OLDS. The Turf Tyke program provides a basic introduction to soccer in a fun and entertaining environment. The format is simple: no teams, no practice, activities organized and run by Kevin Mooney (Rec. Director of Coaching) followed by a 3v3 pickup game to show everyone what our TYKES can do. Players must be 3 years old by December 31st. The season will consist of 6 one hour sessions on Saturday mornings starting Feb. 20th. Registration is \$45.00, which will include a uniform and loads of fun.

Spring Season Rules:

1. Fall season teams will be re-formed where possible so coaches should encourage their players to register.
2. A player's fall team that does not form for the spring season will be assigned to a team by their Commissioner. There will be **NO Draft**. Players will be assigned on a first come basis.
3. Teams will use fall uniforms.
4. A 6-game season will be played beginning February 20, 2010. **NO recreational games will be played on Saturday, March 5, 2010 (Hub City Ford Cajun Lagniappe Tournament). Games will be played Saturdays and Sunday Afternoons.**
5. The brackets for competition will be determined by the teams' final standings in the Fall Season. Spring Season teams and their results will not have a bearing on team formation or bracketing for the next fall season.
6. Boys and Girls teams will be fielded where possible. Coed and/or short –sided teams will be formed when necessary.
7. Participants must be 4 years old on or before December 31, 2009 to play in the spring season.
8. Players of all age groups will play in the same age group as they did or would have in the fall season.
9. **NO REFUNDS AFTER REGISTRATION. The only exception is if a league does not have enough players registered to form.**
