

APPENDIX I

TEAM FORMATION

Drafting order will be as follows:

- 1) Coaches of non-returning teams.
- 2) Coaches coming up from a lower age group coaching non-returning teams.
- 3) Coaches from a returning team from a lower age group.
- 4) Coaches of returning teams from within the same age group.

The drafting order within each grouping will be determined by drawing lots.

The following paragraph shall be repealed effective July 31, 2010:

"A returning team is 6 or more for U-13 and above, 5 or more for U7/8/9/10/11/12, and 4 or more for the U-5/6."

The following paragraph shall be effective only from August 1, 2010 through July 31, 2011 and shall be repealed thereafter:

"A returning team is 6 or more for U-13 and above, 5 or more for U7/8/9/10/11/12, and 4 or more for the U6. All players in the U5 Division shall be electronically assigned to a team"

The following paragraph shall be effective only from August 1, 2011 through July 31, 2012 and shall be repealed thereafter:

"A returning team is 6 or more for U-13 and above, 5 or more for U7/8/9/10/11/12. All players in the U5 and U6 Divisions shall be electronically assigned to a team"

The following paragraph shall be effective from August 1, 2012 and thereafter:

"A returning team is 6 or more for U-13 and above, 5 or more for U8/9/10/11/12. All players in the U5 and U6 Divisions shall be electronically assigned to a team. All U7 and older teams shall be formed using the draft process set forth herein."

The head coach can be the prior year coach or any other coach as long as the addition of a new head coach does not add a player to the team. Each player has right to say that he is or is not going to be on his returning team. The player must exercise this right prior to the draft, either at registration or by contacting his Area Commissioner. The coach does not have the right to reject certain players; that is, a coach takes all of the players who desire to be on the team or he takes none. A coach cannot combine 2 returning teams of 6 or more to form one team. Late

registrants forfeit their returning player status and will be assigned to teams by the Area Commissioner alphabetically in draft order.

Returning team coaches will draft in the rounds designated by the attached chart.

A head coach's child is not included in the draft roster, but is automatically on his father's team. Assistant coach's children are included in the draft. An assistant coach's children are not guaranteed to any team, so if a head coach wants a certain assistant, he will need to draft the assistant's child as soon as possible.

Coaches can only draft players that are present for the callouts. Players that miss the callouts will be assigned to teams alphabetically in draft order by the Area Commissioner.

In U-19 boys, non-returning players will be drafted on a parish wide basis.
